

# October 2019 Christmas Projects

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## ***Still Scenes Snow Globe Card (top left):***

- Card features the following products:
  - Still Scenes Bundle # 153023 – Still Scenes Cling Mount stamp set & Snow Globe Scenes Dies
  - Itty Bitty Christmas Bundle #153019 – Itty Bitty Christmas Stamp Set & Christmas Layers Dies
  - Brightly Gleaming Specialty Designer Series Paper - #150429
  - Copper Foil Sheets - #142042
  - Snow Globe Shaker Domes - #150442
  - Snowflake Sequins - #150443
- Card base – Night of Navy Card stock - 4 ¼" x 11" scored at 5 ½"
- Copper Foil Mat – 4 1/8" x 5 3/8"
- Brightly Gleaming Specialty Designer Series Paper – 4" x 5 ¼"
- Very Vanilla card stock for inside – 4" x 5 ¼"
- Snow Globe base – Night of Navy card stock & Copper Foil Sheet
- Inside of snow globe – all images die cut from Copper Foil Sheet
- Layering Circle Dies – largest Scallop and 2<sup>nd</sup> largest circle are used to create the frame that goes around the globe. You need to cut the circle to wrap around, the base will hide that you cut the circle open.
- Greeting is stamped on Very Vanilla card stock and die cut with Stitched Rectangle Dies.
- How to put the card together:
  - Die cut the snow globe opening about ½" from top of designer paper
  - Cut piece of Whisper White card stock 3 ¾" x 3 ¾"
  - Center the opening of the designer paper over the Whisper White and lightly trace opening on front with pencil
  - Design and add pieces (deer, trees, bears & church) to Whisper White
  - Add Glitter & Snowflake Sequins on top of pieces

- Remove adhesive from the front of the Snow Globe Shaker Dome and adhere to designer series paper, making sure to press down well so there are no openings for the “insides” to escape.
- Peel off backing on back side of dome, adhere to Whisper White, covering over the die cuts.
- Adhere entire piece to the Copper mat on the front of the card
- Add snow globe base with Stampin’ Dimensionals
- Add banner with greeting directly to card front

***Christmas Rose Card (top middle):***

- This card is a *preview of the “Christmastime Is Here” Suite*. This exclusive, limited-time collection of festive, floral coordinating products has everything you need to share love, joy, and creativity this holiday season.
- Products from the Christmastime Is Here Suite will be available starting November 1<sup>st</sup>, while supplies last.
- Whisper White Card base 5 ½” x 8 ½”, scored at 4 ¼”
- Christmastime is Here Specialty Designer Series Paper – 4” x 5 ¼”
- Christmas Rose Bundle (cling mount & photopolymer stamp set with coordinating dies)
- Sentiment is from the stamp set & die cut with matching die.
- Poppy Parade ink & ribbon
- Accents are the Gold Glitter Enamel Dots (part of the suite)

***Feels like Frost Card (top right):***

- Feels Like Frost 6” x 6” Specialty Designer Series Paper - #150444
- Seaside Spray card base 4 ¼” x 11”, scored at 5 ½”
- Night of Navy Cards stock – 4 1/8” x 5 3/8”
- Feels Like Frost designer paper – 4” x 5 ¼”
- Adhere designer paper to the Night of Navy stock, wrap 6” piece of Seaside Spray ¼” Metallic Ribbon around the front and adhere ends with Mini Glue Dots
- Die is from the Ornate Frames Dies, #150664, part of the Monster Bash Halloween Suite
- Greeting is from the hostess set, Greatest Part of Christmas #150554
- Just change the card base & mat to match the designer paper you choose to make a quick and easy set of cards.
- Switch out ribbon for rhinestones or enamel dots as well.

***Watercolor Greetings Cards (bottom right):***

- Very Vanilla card base - 5 ½” x 8 ½”, scored at 4 ¼”
- Mossy Meadow Card stock mat – 3 ¾” x 5 ¼”
- Watercolor Paper – 3 ½” x 5”
- Fill Aqua Painter with water, brush water over the water color paper, then brush again with Real Red Classic Ink
- Once the Real Red is dry, brush over with Clear Wink of Stella
- Use Stamparatus Stamp Positioning tool and Mossy Meadow ink to stamp greeting from the hostess set, Greatest Part of Christmas #150554, you may need to stamp 2-3 times so using stamp positioning tool works great.
- Sparkle Glitter snowflakes are from the Christmas Layers Dies # 150654.

**Let it Snow Holiday Scrapbook (bottom left):**

- Cut 2 pieces of Thick Whisper White cardstock  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{4}$ ", at the ends glue these two together making one long piece. (finished length should be  $14\frac{3}{4}$ ")
- Score on the long side at -  $4\frac{1}{4}$ ",  $5\frac{1}{4}$ ",  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " and  $10\frac{1}{2}$ "
- Cut 3 pieces of Whisper White card stock 4" x 12", score these at 4" and 8" and then glue the ends together making a long accordion
- Mats from card stock:
  - Cover mats are 4" x 4", you will need 4
  - Spine mats are  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 4", you will need 4
- Mats from Designer Paper:
  - Cover mats are  $3\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $3\frac{3}{4}$ ", you will need 4
  - Spine mats are  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{3}{4}$ ", you will need 4
- Mats for accordion center are  $3\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $3\frac{3}{4}$ ", photos can be cut 3"x 3"
- Inside has two Real Red Nested Label dies with die cuts from the Jolly Season Dies, #150648, in Sparkle Glimmer Paper
- Real Red card stock was used to create the belly band (1" wide)
- Basic Black Nested Label die cut layered on top
- Santa is from the Holly Jolly Christmas stamp set #150471, stamped in Memento Black ink, colored with Stampin' Blend Markers and die cut with the coordinating die from Jolly Season Dies
