- Ornate Garden Suite - #154153 - \$136.75
 - Ornate Thanks Bundle - #154115 - \$46.75

- Tropical Oasis Designer Series Paper - #151252 - \$11.50
- Timeless Tropical Bundle - #153811 - \$52.00

Ornate Frame Card (top left):

- Mint Macaron Card base - 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½"
- Piece of Designer Series Paper cut 3 ¼" x 4 ¾", use the frame to help center the paper on the card front before adhering directly to it with your favorite adhesive
- Thick Whisper White card stock was used to die cut the largest frame, which is adhered with Stampin' Dimensionals
- Image was stamped with Versamark Ink on Shimmery White card stock and heat embossed with Black embossing powder. Color using your favorite technique, blends, watercolor pencils or even an Aqua Painter. Add some Stampin' Dimensionals to the middle and adhere overlapping the frame.
- Whisper White card stock banner can be stamped with the greeting of your choice and a Daffodil Delight bow finishes off the card.

Daisy Card (top middle):

- Old Olive card stock and Whisper White both cut - 4 ¼" x 4 ¼"
- Ornate Garden Specialty Designer Series Paper cut 4" x 4", then cut on the diagonal – when cutting on the diagonal, sink your trimmer blade in the middle of the paper then cut, this way you don't tear up the ends
- Adhere designer paper to one corner of the Old Olive
- Take a strip of Soft Suede card stock cut about 6 ½" long and just over ¼" wide, back with Tear N Tape, peel off backing and adhere across Old Olive at the seam of the designer paper.
- Match up the Old Olive & Whisper White card stock squares and in one corner, punch a hole through both pieces of card stock – adhere together with brad (Metallic brads - #146929 - \$4.50)
- Using Whisper White card stock punch out 2 large & 2 medium daisies, adhere together and gently curl ends with bone folder
- Use Mint Macaron card stock and punch out 3 leaf's with Leaf Punch
- Dry fit (no adhesive) the flower & leaf's to card front and stamp desired greeting
- Add Daisy with Stampin' Dimensional and leaf's with liquid glue
- Finish off with Gold or Clear Faceted Gem (I did not have any gold faceted gems, so I colored a clear faceted gem with a Stampin' Blend marker)
- Stamp inside with greeting of your choice.
- *** the designer paper used for this card has a new 2020-2022 In-Color, can you guess what that is?

Pineapple Card (top right):

- Whisper White card stock base – 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½"
- Tropical Oasis Designer Series Paper cut 4" x 5 ¼", adhered directly to card front
- Pineapple die cut from "In the Tropics" Dies
 - Crushed Curry & Mossy Meadow card stock
 - Destress with some ink if desired
 - Adhere directly to card front
- Aloha die cut in Grapefruit Grove
- Sentiment of your choice on the inside

Just wanted to say Card (bottom):

- Early Espresso card stock base – 5 ½" x 8 ½", scored at 4 ¼"
- Flirty Flamingo Card stock 3 ¾" x 5 ½"
- Ornate Garden Specialty Designer Series Paper – 2" x 5 3/8"
- Gold Foil – 2" x 6" and run through the die cutting machine using one of the Ornate Border dies (there are little sticks close to one side on the ends – that's the side that cuts)
- Adhere the designer paper to gold foil, cutting off the excess gold foil sheet, add this piece to the Flirty Flamingo card stock piece
- Wrap about 7" of ribbon around, adhere in the back with mini glue dots
- Adhere entire piece to the card front with Stampin' Dimensionals
- Add bow with Mini Glue dot
- Whisper White 4" x 5 ¼" for inside, stamp with desired greeting
