You Can Do This Card (left):

- Night of Navy Card base 5 ½" x 8 ½", scored at 4 ¼"
- Gold Foil Sheet 3 ¾" x 5"
- Whisper White for stamping 3 5/8" x 4 7/8"
- Whisper White for banner and Gold Foil Sheet to mat banner sizes for these piece can all be based on greeting you choose to use. My Whisper White is ¾" wide and 2 ¾" long, I then adhered to the Gold Foil and hand trimmed it out. Adhere to card front with Stampin' Dimensionals once images are stamped.
- Inks used for stamping images from the Forever Fern Stamp Set is Night of Navy and Bermuda Bay.
- Gilded Gems, #152478, add one of each size
- Inside has 4" x 5 ½" piece of Whisper White stamped with same images bottom left side

Love & Laughter Card (bottom):

- Whisper White Card stock base 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½"
- Shaded Spruce card stock mat 4" x 5 ¼"
- Forever Greenery Designer Paper 3 ½" x 5"
- Forever Gold Foil Laser-Cut Specialty Paper, adhere to the DSP using liquid adhesive on the outside edges
- Banner 1" x 4", Whisper White card stock, stamped in Shaded Spruce ink and then adhered with Stampin' Dimensionals.

Triple Easel Card (right):

- Card is using Tasteful Touches Bundle & In Good Taste Designer Series Paper
- Small flowers Rococo Rose card stock was stamped using coordinating ink using a background image stamp from the Tasteful Touches stamp set then punched out using the Small Bloom punch, Rhinestone or Pearls added in the center. Flowers adhered direct to card.
- Larger flower from the Floral Essence stamp set, stamped twice and punched out with the Perennial Flower Punch, add Dimensional's between layers. Leaves are from the same stamp set and punched out using the retired Leaf Punch. You can either hand cut out if you don't have that punch or use another leaf die/punch you have.
- Greeting stamped in Early Espresso from the Tasteful Touches stamp set and die cut with die from the Tasteful Label Dies (part of the bundle)
- Suggestion for writing on card, die cut 2nd label, write on and adhere to back if desired

Whisper White card stock pieces:

- 4" x 12" scored at 4" 6" 8"
- 3" x 9" scored at 3" 4 ½" 6"
- 2" x 6" scored at 2" 3" 4"
- 4" x 5" for base, I used the thick cardboard that in with designer series paper

Card stock for mats – 2 of each size:

- 3 ¾" x 3 ¾"
- 2 ¾" x 2 ¾"
- 1 ¾" x 1 ¾"
- 1" x 4" only 1 of this size to adhere to Whisper White base piece

Designer Series Paper – 2 of each size:


- 3 ½" x 3 ½"
- 2 ½" x 2 ½"
- 1 ½" x 1 ½"

How to put together:

- Adhere designer series paper to the card stock mats
- Adhere the 1" x 4" card stock piece to the 4" x 5" base at one end, the folded Easel card will be attached to the remaining 4" x 4" part of the base.
- Fold and burnish each of the Whisper White card stock pieces
- Photos on the next page show you how to take each piece and create the "Easel"
- Adhere matted designer paper to the Easel card pieces
- Adhere largest, then middle size, then smallest centering each
- Punch out 2 banners, glue together, add with Dimensionals to base as a stopper for the smallest Easel portion
- Decorate each Easel piece as desired

Easel card photo 1:

Fold each Whisper White piece like the photo below:




Easel card photo 2:

Portion on the right hand side of middle fold need to be adhered together. End the right portion will fold down to create the easel
