Featured Products this Month:

- Blossoms in Bloom Bundle - # 154123 - \$60.25
- Flowers for Every Season 6"x6" Designer Series Paper - # 152486 - \$11.50
- Lovely Labels Pick a Punch - # 152883 - \$23.00

Blushing Bride Birthday (top left):

- Featuring the dies from the Blossoms and Bloom Bundle
- Blushing Bride card stock card base – 5 ½" x 8 ½", scored at 4 ¼"
- Rich Razzleberry card stock 4 ¼" x 5 ½" for die cutting flower base
- Blushing Bride card stock 4 ¼" x 5 ½" for die cutting fine line flower overlay, this one I adhered to an Adhesive Sheet #152334 - \$10 (12 sheets 6" x 12")
- Adhere flower pieces together and adhere to the card base using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals
- Whisper White card stock ½" x 5 ½" for greeting banner
- Punch one end of the banner, stamp greeting in Rich Razzleberry Ink then punch the other end, adhered to flower die

Matching Note Card & Full Size card (full size card top right):

- Featuring the stamp set from the Blossoms and Bloom Bundle
- Whisper White card stock card base – 5 ½" x 8 ½", scored at 4 ¼" and Whisper White Note card
- Flower image stamped with Daffodil Delight Ink
- Flower centers stamped with Pacific Point ink
- Leaves stamped with Granny Apple Green ink
- ½" or ¾" strips of Whisper White for greetings
- Rhinestones for sparkle or to hide a "boo-boo"
- Do not forget to stamp the envelopes!

Triple Box Card:

- Card stock for boxes:
 - 4" x 8½" – score at 2" – 4" – 6" – 8"
 - 2 pieces 2" x 8½" - score at 2" – 4" – 6" – 8"
- Mats -10 pieces – 1 ¾" x 1 ¾"
- Designer Series paper – 6 pieces – 1 ½" x 1 ½"
- Whisper White card stock 1 ¾" x 3 ¾" for writing – I would recommend, stamping if you like, write on piece of card stock – then adhere to the back of the card
- Adhere three boxes together
 - Adhere the 2 smaller boxes to the front of the card
- Adhere designer paper to mat, then to boxes
 - 2 of the mats go inside the small boxes once adhered to the larger box

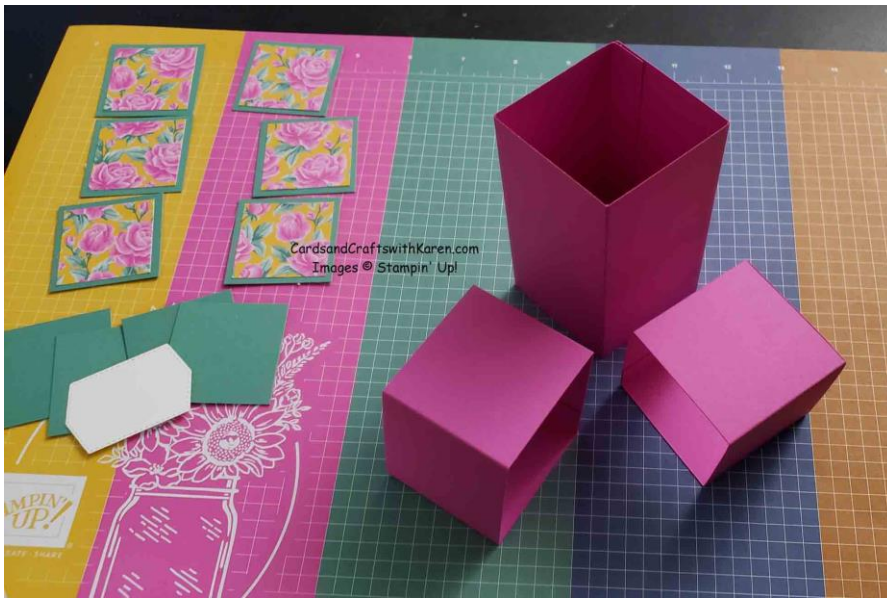
Box photo 1 – all the pieces needed, including the score line:



Box photo 2 – burnish scores on the box pieces and glue together using the ½" tab (use a strong adhesive) and adhere the designer series paper to the mats – 4 should remain plain.



Box photo 3 – once all 3 boxes are complete, put the seam of the taller box in the back and adhere to 2 smaller boxes like below, only adhere one square so that the boxes will fold flat.



Box photo 4: Once the 3 boxes are adhered together, add the matted designer paper



Box photo 5 – add the four remaining pieces of card stock inside and decorate as desired. In the main photo I used a die from the Tasteful Label Dies.
