All Things Fabulous (top left):

- Misty Moonlight card stock card base 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½"
- Very Vanilla card stock 4" x 5 1/4" for inside
- In Good Taste Designer Series Paper − 3 ½" x 4 ¾" for stamping
- Night of Navy Card stock 3 ¾" x 5" for mat
- Strip of designer paper for stamping greeting and Night of Navy card stock strip for matting
- Flowers (2 and 3 step stamping) stamped in the following ink colors:
 - Crushed Curry then Bumblebee
 - Seaside Spray, Misty Moonlight then Night of Navy
- Leaves are stamped in Granny Apple Green ink
- Once the designer series paper is stamped, the piece is run through your embossing machine using the Tasteful Textile 3D Embossing folder, added to the Night of Navy mat then to the card base
- Greeting strip can be adhered directly to card or with Stampin' Dimensionals.

Fabulous Doily Christmas Card & Full Size card (middle):

- Whisper White card stock card base 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½"
- Tis the Season 6"x 6" Designer Series Paper − 3 ¾" x 5", adhered directly to card base
- Stamp 2 large flowers in Real Red ink and die cut (images a and b)
- Stamp 1 of each leaf image in Shaded Spruce or Garden Green and die cut
- Lay the Square Vellum Doily, centered from top & sides on designer series paper
- Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the flowers and use them to adhere the doily to the paper
- Add leaf's making sure to add a Mini Stampin' Dimensional to the tip and Mini Glue Dot to the bottom
- 3 Holiday Rhinestone Basic Jewels for accents

Card with a Box – 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " tall version: - this is based on my Card with a Box that is based on a horizontal card 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " tall by 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " long – Sample above is using the Gilded Autumn Specialty Designer Series Paper.

- Card base = 5 ½" x 10 5/8", scored at 4 ¼"
- Box 8 ½" x 10 ½"
 - Score 8" side at 2" 4" 6" 8"
 - Score 10 ½" side at the 2" mark on both ends
 - Layers for the box:
 - Card stock mat or Designer Series Paper 1 ¾" x 5 ¼" need 3 of these for the sides
 - Inside layer if using card stock mat 1 ½" x 5" need 3 of these for the sides
 - Card stock mat or Designer Series Paper − 1 ¾" x 1 ¾" − need 2 one for top & bottom
 - Inside layer if using card stock mat 1 ½" x 1 ½" need 2 one for top & bottom
- Directions on how to put the box together:
 - o Burnish all score lines of the box, cut along the score marks at the top & bottom of box.
 - On the 8 ½ side, cut the small rectangles off on the ½" wide strip
 - Put box together using liquid glue or Stampin' Seal, only closing bottom of box
 - Adhere ribbon around 2 sides and bottom
 - Adhere designer paper on three sides and bottom, this hides ribbon on the side and bottom, the back of the box does not get designer series paper, this is what is attached to the card
 - Once card is completed, fill box and tie ribbon into a bow
