

# November 2020 Sunday Stamper Cards

## Featured Products this Month:

- Queen Anne Lace Stamp Set
- Curvy Christmas Stamp Set
- Dies from the Quite Curvy Bundle
- VersaMark Ink, Clear Embossing Powder & Heat Tool
- Love of Leaves Stamp Set along with Buffalo Check & Dandelion Wishes Stamp sets

## Hello Friend Card (top left):

- Card base – 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½" for a top folding card
- Card stock (matches the base) – 2 ¾" x 4 ¼", embossed with your favorite folder (I've used the Absolutely Argyle 3D Embossing Folder) – adhered directly to the card base
- Gray Granite mat – 2 1/8" x 4 ¼" – adhered with Stampin' Dimensionals
- Whisper White card stock for stamping – 2" x 4 1/8"
- Whisper White circle punch with 1 ½" circle punch
- About 6" – 8" of coordinating ribbon
- Layer ribbon in half, adhere to back of stamped circle, then to card front
- Above sample is Petal Pink

### **Combo Technique Card – Joseph Coats + Kissing (top right):**

- Crumb Cake card base – 5 ½" x 8 ½", scored and folded at 4 ¼"
- Coastal Cabana mat 3 ¾" x 5"
- Whisper White for stamping 3 ½" x 4 ¾"
- Joseph's Coat Technique:
  - Using sponge daubers or cut up sponge pieces add ink randomly to the Whisper White card stock using a minimum of three different colors – light to dark and don't be afraid to have the colors overlay a little. I've used Crushed Curry, Coastal Cabana and Highland Heather on my card.
  - Don't worry if the card stock looks like a hot mess – if it does – you know you are doing it right
  - Before starting the next step, make sure ink is dry
- Now here is where we mix in the "Kissing" Technique
  - Ink solid stamp image with Versamark ink (I used Love of Leaves)
  - Ink detail stamp image with Memento Black ink (I've used Buffalo Check or Dandelion Wishes)
  - Press Versamark inked stamp into the black inked stamped – then stamp to the paper
  - Clean stamps – then stamp a few more times
  - Sprinkle with Clear Embossing Powder and use your Heat Tool to set the powder
- Back to the Joseph's Coat Technique:
  - Swipe either a Memento Black or Rich Razzleberry or Blackberry Bliss ink pad over the entire embossed card stock piece until you like the background color
  - Wipe excess ink off embossed images using a dry paper towel
  - Make sure dry, add to mat then to card front
- Stamp sentiment of your choice and add to card front

### **Curvy Christmas Card (bottom):**

- Quite Curvy Bundle, #156228 - \$41.25 – item from the new January – June 2021 catalog that you can purchase now
- Curvy Christmas Stamp Set, #155364 - \$21
- Sahara Sand card base – 5 ½" x 8 ½", scored and folded at 4 ¼"
- Classic Christmas 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper (#155969 - \$11.50):
  - Colors: Cherry Cobbler, Shaded Spruce & Sahara Sand
  - Front – 2" x 5 ¼"
  - Inside – 3" x 5 ¼"
- Whisper White card stock:
  - Front – 3" x 5 ¼" – die cut with the wavy die about in the middle
  - Inside – 4" x 5 ¼" – die cut with the wavy die about in the middle (only need 1 for the card)
- Front:
  - Add designer paper to the middle of the front
  - Stamp on the Whisper White pieces using either stamp set and adhere to card front directly or with Stampin' Dimensionals
- Inside:
  - Add designer paper to the top of the inside
  - Stamp on the Whisper White adhere either completely to the inside of the card or only on three sides (Sides & Bottom) so you can add a gift card
