#### Dragonfly Card (top right):

- Dandy Garden Memories & More Card & Envelope
- Mossy Meadow Card stock mats: 2 2 1/8" x 2 1/8" and 1 2 1/8" x 4 5/8"
- Dandy Garden 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper: 2 2" x 2" and 1 2" x 4 1/2"
- Square Vellum Doily
- Basic White paper to stamp 3 Dragonflies (about 2" x 8 ½")
- Many Messages Bundle stamp and die cut using Memento Black Ink on Basic White paper use the greeting of your choice!
- Once all designer paper is adhered to the card stock adhere squares at opposite corners directly to the card base, add doily in the middle of card front then long piece on top, directly to card front
- Stamp and die cut dragonflies. There is only 1 "wing" stamp, use for both sided, once stamped is to look abstract.
- Add dragonflies and greeting to card front using Stampin' Dimensionals

## Purple Posy Art Gallery card (top left)

- Purple Posy card stock card base 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½" for a top folding card
- Gorgeous Grape card stock mat 3 7/8" x 5 1/8"
- Basic White card stock 3 ¾" x 5" embossed with Painted Texture 3D Embossing Folder
- If desired use a Blending Brush to add color to the Basic White, I lightly added Highland Heather ink
- Adhere Gorgeous Grape & Basic White card stock directly to card base
- Leaf Image is Pear Pizzazz ink on Pear Pizzazz card stock, die cut and added with Stampin' Dimensionals
- For the greeting, I have done better die cutting the long or short label from the die cut then stamping the greeting of my choice, which is then adhered with Mini Stampin' Dimensionals
- Flower uses the new Gilded Leafing Embellishment and Heat & Stick Powder
  - Purple Posy Card stock
  - Stamp first image with either Highland Heather or Gorgeous Grape ink
  - o Stamp second image with Versamark Ink and sprinkle over with Heat & Stick Powder
  - Use your heat tool to melt the Heat & Stick Powder, immediately add Gilded Leafing, brushing off any excess. You will not get 100% cover but that is ok – you are looking for add texture with this
  - Add flower with Stampin' Dimensionals
- Add Champagne Rhinestones

Suggestion – store your Gilded Leafing is a large container with high sides, it is easier to use. The leafing "expands" once you open the container and storing it in something larger makes it easier to work with. I use a sponge brush from the \$1 store to brush off any excess.

#### Art Gallery Acetate card (bottom middle):

- Merry Merlot card stock card base 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½" for a top folding card
  - Golden Garden Acetate Sheet and Fine Art Floral Designer Series Paper There are 2 sheets of the acetate that match the designer series paper that is what you want to use here. Cut both 4" x 5 ¼"
  - Run a piece of Tear & Tape about 1 ¼" from the bottom on the front of the acetate, add ribbon, then add another piece of Tear & Tape on the opposite side of acetate so you can adhere to the designer series paper
  - Add designer paper to the card front
- Label is from Tasteful Label Dies die cut with Basic White
  - Stamp flower in Petal Pink or Flirty Flamingo ink first
  - Top ink color is Merry Merlot
  - Mossy Meadow ink for leaf
  - For the sentiment, I covered one word with a post-it notes, inked the image, and stamped did this twice to get the Happy and Birthday each on a separate line
  - Add to card front using Stampin' Dimensionals
