- Biggest Wish Photopolymer Stamp Set - #155052
- Brights 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper Pack - #155228

Daisy Garden Card (bottom):

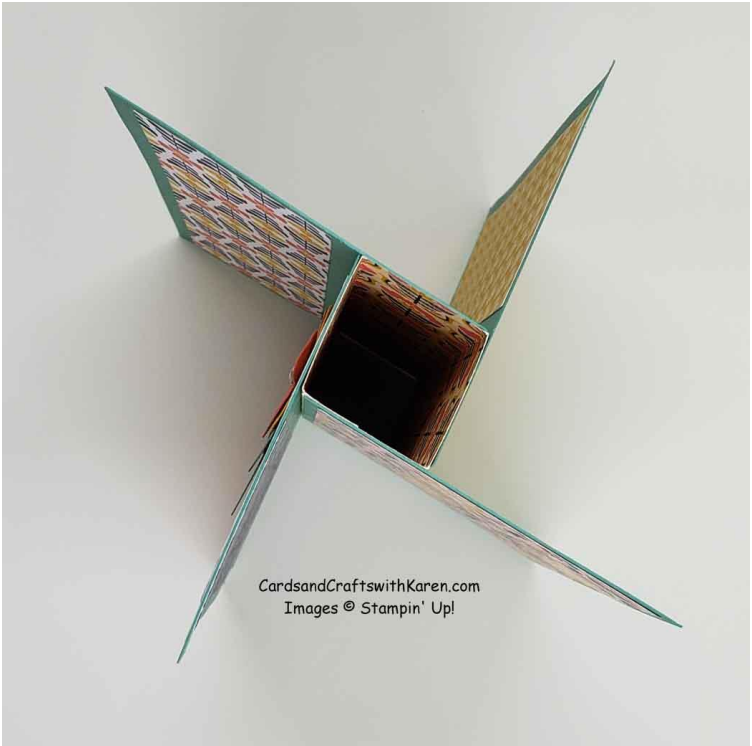
- Soft Sea Foam card stock base – 5 ½" x 8 ½", scored at 4 ¼"
- Pear Pizzazz card stock mat – 3 ¾" x 5"
- Soft Sea Foam card stock for stamping – 3 ½" x 4 ½"
- Using the Daisy Garden stamp, stamp the image in Soft Sea Foam ink on the 3 ½" x 4 ½" piece of card stock.
- Next cut the image just stamped in three equal pieces (1 ½" x 3 ½")
- Adhere cut pieces to the Pear Pizzazz card stock mat, easiest to do the outside two pieces first, then the middle
- Adhere to card front
- Stamp sentiment of your choice in Pear Pizzazz ink on Pear Pizzazz card stock and adhere with Stampin' Dimensionals
- Add three Opal Round Embellishments

Brights Strips Card: (top right)

- Very Vanilla card base 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½" or 5 ½" x 8 ½", scored at 4 ¼"
- Cut 7 strips of Brights Designer Series Paper each ½" x 6"
- Add strips to card front, pieces are longer than needed, you will cut off excess, this way you know the strips will be the needed length
- Start with the two ends, then middle, then the two pieces in between. I like to lay them on the card front before adhering with liquid glue.
- Die cut Very Vanilla card stock circle for stamping and Scalloped Circle from Vellum card stock for layering.
- Stamp words of your choice from the Biggest Wish Photopolymer Stamp Set, stamp one word in a lighter color, then the second word in a darker. I have used Mango Melody and Pacific Point on my card.

Pinwheel Card (top left):

- Card stock and Designer Series Paper needed for card (using a 6" x 6" square envelope from Amazon for packaging)
 - "Inside Square" center of the card is Designer Series Paper 4 ½" x 6" , scored on the 4 ½" side at 1" – 2" – 3" – 4" and adhered using the extra ½" to complete a square. The design you want to see when looking down into the card should be the pattern on the inside of the square
 - Four pieces of card stock 3" x 6" and four pieces of designer series paper 2 ¾" x 5 ¾" to mat on the card stock. I have found it easier to add the designer series paper to the card stock, before adding the card stock to the "inside square".
 - Four pieces of designer series paper 1 ¾" x 5 ¾"
 - Two Basic White Scalloped Contour Die Cuts for stamping
 - Flowers punched from the Flowers & Leaves Punch, part of the Flowers of Friendship Bundle
 - For the card you can use the sentiments and punch out/die cuts of your choice.
 - Faceted Gems were added to the center of the flowers.
 - Best to not make your decorations too dimensional, so the card fits in the envelope.
- Once you have the "Inside Square" complete, on each side of the square you will add one of the 3" x 6" piece of card stock. If you are a little unsure what it should look like, dry fit (just hold the papers to the square) – photos at the end will help.
- Once all four sides are added, adhere the remaining 1 ¾" x 5 ¾" designer series paper
- Stamp the desired greetings and images on the Basic White die cuts and add to the card
- Decorate as desired



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
