## Bamboo Beauty card (top left)

- Thick Basic White card stock base 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½"
- 4 ¼" x 5 ½" piece of Basic White card stock which I have used the largest label from the Seasonal Labels Dies, part of the Christmas Season Bundle, to die cut the opening out of the center of the card stock.
- Use the negative space (part with the die cut out) as a stencil and using a Blending Brush, add Soft Succulent ink.
- Use Evening Evergreen ink to stamp images and sentiment from the Bamboo Beauty stamp set.

## Christmas Pinecone Tag (center):

- For the tag, we are using the Basic White die cut label from the Bamboo Beauty card.
- Use a hand punch to create the hole for the ribbon
- Stamp sets – Christmas Season (pinecones) and Christmas to Remember (sentiment)
- Pinecones are 2 step stamping – first Crumb Cake, then Soft Suede; Greenery is stamped using Evening Evergreen and Sentiment is Cherry Cobbler

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- Made hole protector using a hand punch and scrap of Cherry Cobbler card stock, punch the hole then use a ½" circle punch to punch out the actual circle hole protector
- 6" piece of ribbon for hanger
- Write your message on the back

**Pretty Pumpkin card:**

- Cinnamon Cider card base 5 ½" x 8 ½", scored at 4 ¼"
- Card front:
  - Blackberry Bliss card stock mat – 4" x 5 ¼"
  - Very Vanilla card stock – 3 ¾" x 5"
  - Cinnamon Cider ink for sentiment
  - Pumpkins – Designer Series Paper, Gold Vellum and Brushed Metallic
- Card inside:
  - Blackberry Bliss card stock mats – 4" x 5 ¼", cut and add to the inside
  - Designer Paper 5" x 8 1/8", fold in half then , then score ¾" away from the center fold on both sides
  - The center fold will be a mountain fold and scores on either side will be valley folds, fold, and burnish score lines
  - Starting on the left side, add designer series paper with an even border around the edges, fold the designer series paper, add adhesive to the other end of the designer series paper and close the card to adhere. This will help you make sure the card will close properly.
  - I've found that using liquid adhesive when adding the designer series paper gives you that few seconds of wiggle room if needed.
  - Picture This Die cuts for the three strips, or you can use card stock – 2 - 1 ¼" x 2 ¾" and 1 - 1" x 3"
  - Make sure when adding any die cut images to the inside of the card, they don't go over the edge when the card is closed.
