Daffodil Card:

- Card stock base 5 ½" x 8 ½", scored at 2 ¾" and 7"
- Designer Series Paper 2 ½" x 5 ¼" and 1 ¼" x 5 ¼" and strip 1" x 4" for greeting
- Card stock mat 2 ¾" x 4 ¼"
- Very Vanilla or Basic White card stock 2 ½" 4" (all depends on designer series paper used)
- Daffodil Delight and Crushed Curry card stock to die cut flower and Old Olive card stock for stem/leaves
- Flowers adhered with Stampin' Dimensionals
- Memento Black ink for greeting

Ladybug Card:

- Card stock base 5 ½" x 8 ½", scored at 4 ¼"
- Two Pieces of Designer Series Paper 2" x 5 ¼"
- Largest Scalloped Rectangle from the Stitched So Sweetly Dies in Very Vanilla or Basic White
- Inks: Granny Apple Green, Flirty Flamingo and Memento Black
- Basic Black & Flirty Flamingo card stock to punch out Ladybug
- Ladybugs are adhered with Stampin' Dimensionals.

One of a Kind Card (shaving cream & reinker's used with Plenty of Patterns Decorative Masks for background):

- Card stock base 5 ½" x 8 ½", scored at 4 ¼"
- Shimmery White card stock 4" x 5 ¼"
- Card stock mat 2 ½" x 5 ¼"
- Basic White card stock 2 ¼" x 5 ¼"
- First stamp image from Amazing Silhouettes stamp set using the Stamparatus using Mango Melody ink, then
 again using the Stamparatus stamp the greeting from the Slim Sayings Stamp Set in Blackberry Bliss ink (you may
 need to stamp a few times for a nice dark image)
- To create the background
 - Start with piece of Shimmery White card stock 4" x 5 ¼"
 - Add a mask over the card stock (tape ends down if you prefer, I just held them down with my hand)
 - O Using White FOAM shaving cream and apply a thin layer about 4" x 4" in size to a piece of wax paper
 - Add drops of re-inker (I used 4 colors: Daffodil Delight, Balmy Blue, Flirty Flamingo & Gorgeous Grape)
 - Use toothpick to swirl the colors together just don't over mix (or you get mud color)
 - Pickup a small portion of shaving cream using an old gift card/credit card
 - Drag the shaving cream down the mask to add color to the card stock, may need to do this a few times to cover entire piece of card stock. One portion of shaving cream should work for one background.
 - Use remaining shaving cream on other piece of card stock for backgrounds
 - o Run mask under warm water and clean with dish soap, dry well.
