New Horizon Card (top left):

- Blackberry Bliss card base 5 ½" x 8 ½", scored at 4 ¼"
- New Horizons Designer Series Paper 4" x 5 ¼", die cut with the Layering Diorama Dies
- When adding DSP to the card base the 2nd and 3rd layers are adhered with Stampin' Dimensionals (2 layers of Dimensionals if needed)
- Center piece of DSP is adhered directly to the card base
- Fence in Thick Basic White card stock from the On the Horizon Bundle and adhered with liquid glue
- Die cut houses or trees if desired and add in the middle
- For the Finishing touch add Pebble Enamel Shapes

Sentimental Swirl Card (top right):

- Crumb Cake Card stock base 5 ½" x 8 ½", scored at 4 ¼"
- Basic White card stock 4" x 5 ¼"
- Stamp image with Memento Black in closer to the left side of the Basic White card stock, stamp bird and leaves
- Using your choice of the Basic Border Dies, die cut right side of Basic White card stock
- Stamp 3 flowers on scrap of Basic White card stock first with Memento Black for the outline, then colored ink for the 2nd step. Punch out using the Flowers & Leaves Punch. Add to card using Mini Stampin' Dimensional.
- Sentiment stamped in Memento Black Ink and punched out with the Tailored Tag Punch.
- Rhinestones, Matte Black Dots and Linen bow finish off the card

Waves of Ocean Double Z Fold Card:

- Pacific Point card stock base 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 2 ¾" and 5 ½"
- Waves of the Ocean Designer Paper 2 pieces 2 ½" x 4" and 1 piece 4" x 5 ¼"
- Basic White card stock 3 ½" x 9 ¾", scored at 4 ¼" and 7"
- DO NOT score Basic White card stock until after waves are stamped
- Using the Stamparatus, stamp wave twice starting on the left side of the card stock
 - o 1st Coastal Cabana ink
 - o 2nd Pacific Point ink (touch the stamp in a few places with ink pad or use a sponge dauber)
 - o 3rd Night of Navy ink (touch the stamp in a few places with ink pad or use a sponge dauber)
- Stamp pelican image using Gray Granite ink, I placed a post-it note just under the water line before stamping to make it appear seamless
- Stamp birds and greetings, then score and add to card base
- Die cut a wave using a piece of the Blue Foils Specialty Papers and adhere to card, cut off any excess
- Rhinestone Waves Basic Jewels add just the needed bling!
