Featured Products this Month:

- Best Witches Cling Mount Stamp Set - #159860 - \$21.00
- Season of Chic Bundle (photopolymer stamps and dies) - #158816 - \$57.50
- Lovely & Lasting Bundle (photopolymer stamps and punch) - #158652 - \$36.75

Best Witches Card (left):

- Card base is Granny Apple Green card stock 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½"
- 5 strips of designer paper ¾" x 4 ½" (I have used Celebrate Everything Host Reward July-Dec 22 catalog), attached in any order and staggered on the card front.
- The pumpkins are colored with Stampin' Blend Markers (Pumpkin Pie and Old Olive)
- Highland Heather card stock mat 3 ¼" x 3 ¼" (adhered with Stampin' Dimensionals)
- Basic White card stock die cut with the largest square from the Stylish Shapes Dies (#159183). Banner also uses a die from the set for the greeting.
- Image and greeting both stamped in Memento Black ink.
- Greeting adhered with Stampin' Dimensionals on the corners.
- Image colored using Stampin' Blend Marker Combo Packs including Basic Black, Granny Apple Green, Pumpkin Pie, Daffodil Delight, Crumb Cake, Smoky Slate, Highland Heather, and Real Red.

Fall Split Design Card (right):

- Card base is Very Vanilla card stock 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½"
- Soft Suede card stock 4" x 5 ¼" die cut with one of the dies from the Split Card Textures Dies #159162.
- Use the Season of Chic Bundle to die cut leaves from Evening Evergreen and Melody Mango card stock along with Texture Chic Specialty Designer Series Paper.
- Stamp greeting on Very Vanilla card stock with Soft Suede ink and die cut using die from Stitched Rectangle Dies.
- Dry fit (place the greeting there is will go on the card front) then stamp three leaves in the bottom left corner of the Soft Suede card stock using Soft Suede ink.
- Adhere Soft Suede piece directly to card front.
- Add leaves then piece of Petal Pink ribbon (#159192) about 2 ¾" long
- Add greeting with Stampin' Dimensionals
- 3 Rustic Metallic Adhesive Backed Dots (#159082) finish the card
- I have stamped a leaf and additional greeting on the inside using Soft Suede ink.

Lovely and Lasting Card (middle):

Template for the card from Connie Stewart – Easy Triple Fold Card

- Basic White card stock base 5 ½" x 11", scored at 1 ¼" – 5 ½" – 9 ¼"
- 5 ½" score line is the fold on the right side of the card, 9 ¼" score folds over the front
- Designer Series Paper (I have used Lovely in Linen 12" x 12" DSP - #158644 – annual catalog)
 - 2 pieces – 1" x 5 ¼" and 1 piece – 1 ½" x 5 ¼"
 - Optional for inside either 4" x 5 ¼" or 3 ½" x 5 ¼"
- Add designer paper to the card base
- Sweet Sorbet card stock – 3 ¼" x 4 ¼" mat and will be adhered directly to belly band
- Basic White card stock – 3" x 4" for stamped image from Lovely & Lasting Bundle. I have used Night of Navy ink and my Stamparatus.
- Card stock for belly band – 1" x 11" (I have used Pale Papaya), wrap around, secure in front (cut off any excess card stock. Adhere stamped image unit to belly band covering where paper pieces were joined.
- Greeting stamped in Night of Navy, Pale Papaya and Sweet Sorbet ink and punch out with coordinating punch from the bundle. I have added with three Stampin' Dimensionals, making sure not to adhere to card front, just the belly band.
- Fine Sparkle Adhesive Backed Gems finish the card.
