Featured Products this Month:

- Fitting Florets Bundle (stamp set & dies) - #163129
 - Framed & Festive Cling Stamp Set - #160888
- Fitting Florets 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper - #161814
- Gold Adhesive-Backed Swirls - #161822 (great flat embellishment!)
 - Cottage Wreath Bundle (stamp set & dies) - #159659
- Gingham Cottage 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper - #159651

Pocket Card (top left):

- Fitting Florets Designer Series Paper used for pocket card – 6" x 9 ¼"
 - Score 9 ¼" side at 2 ¾" and 7"
 - Score 6" side at 5 ½"
- Fold and burnish score lines, fold and cut per image below, also punch or die cut a ½ moon shape in the middle section to use as a thumb pull
- I've used Tear & Tape to adhere together, side to side then bottom to middle for a finished look
- Below instructions show how the card above was put together, class attendees will have different pieces of the designer paper to make their project.
- Polished Pink and Basic White card stock used to die cut frame & insert piece. There will be pieces left over for a second card if desired.

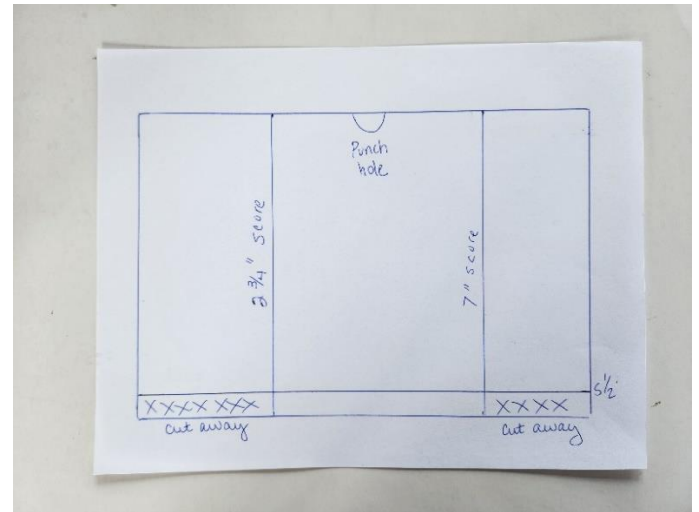
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- Front Insert piece stamped in Night of Navy and Polished Pink ink with stamps from the Fitting Florets Bundle, both pieces are adhered directly to the front of the pocket
- For the card to put inside I've used Balmy Blue 4" x 5 1/4" and Basic White 3 3/4" x 5" card stock
- I've stamped image from stamp set in Polished Pink ink (stamp off first), then sentiment in Night of Navy ink
- If desired, punch a hole using hole punch from the office supply store and add about 9" of ribbon. I've used Balmy Blue and White 3/8" Double Stitched Ribbon
- If you start with a piece of designer series paper 6" x 12", you can use the left over 2 3/4" x 6" to either decorate the envelope to coordinate or cut down and add to pull out card (bottom & sides only) to hold a gift card!



Bright & Cheerful Christmas card(top right):

- Thick Basic White card base - 4 1/4" x 11", scored at 5 1/2"
- Celebrate Everything Designer Series Paper (\$18 host reward Mini Catalog):
 - 2 pieces – 1" x 4" (vertical)
 - 1 piece 1" x 5" (vertical)
 - 1 piece 1" x 4" (horizontal)
- Basic Black card stock mats:
 - 2 pieces – 1 1/8" x 4 1/8"
 - 1 piece – 1 1/8" x 5 1/8"
- Mat three of the pieces of designer paper on the Basic Black and adhered to the card front
- Adhere final 1" x 4" DSP horizontally using Stampin' Dimensionals
- Sentiment is from the limited edition Framed & Festive Cling Stamp Set, stamped in Pacific Point ink on Basic White card stock
- Punch out sentiment using the Label Me Lovely Punch #151296 and adhere to horizontal DSP
- I've coordinated the envelope flap with a piece of DSP 3" x 6" with excess cut away

Cottage Wreath Card (middle):

- Days to Remember Stamp Set (annual catalog #155026) for the Happy Birthday, all other stamping is from the Cottage Wreath Stamp Set
- Crumb Cake card base - 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½"
- Gingham Cottage DSP – one of each size in coordinating colors - 2" x 5" and 1" x 4"
- Basic White card stock 2" x 4 ¼" run through your favorite embossing folder, I've used the Fern 3D Folder
- Used the largest square from the Stylish Shapes Dies for the wreath, which is adhered with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Colors for Birthday card – Soft Suede, Pumpkin Pie, Mint Macaron and Crushed Curry
- Colors for Christmas card – Garden Green and Real Red
- Embellishment of your choice
