## Sweet Citrus Card (top right):

- So Saffron card base $41 / 4 " \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ scored at $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ for top folding card
- Basic White card stock $33 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ stamped with flowers and fruit images in Crushed Curry and So Saffron and adhered directly to the card front
- 3 pieces of Dandy Designer $12^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ Designer Series Paper (\#160836 SAB Level 2 ) cut at $3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4$ " adhered to the center of the stamped Basic White card stock
- Scrap Basic White card stock about $41 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2 \prime$ to stamp fruit, flowers, and leaves
- First stamp the fruit outline using Crushed Curry, then stamp the inside with So Saffron; die cut with coordinating die; line up in the Embossing Folder and run through the Stampin' Cut \& Emboss Machine.
- Stamp leaves in Garden Green ink, flowers in Orchid Oasis ink and die cut. There 2 dies for both leaves and flowers which makes this easier to do!
- Adhere fruit, leaves and flowers to the card front using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals and Glue dots
- Greeting is stamped on $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ Basic White card stock strip in Orchid Oasis, banner cut ends to desired length and add to card front using Stampin' Dimensionals


## Beautifully Happy Card (top left)

- Beautifully Happy Distinktive 2-Step Stamp Set - \#160804
- Basic White card stock base $-41 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ scored at $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ for top folding card
- Soft Succulent card stock mat $-23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$
- Delicate Desert Designer Series Paper (\#160521) - $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 43 / 4$ "
- Dry Brushed Metallic Specialty Designer Series Paper (\#160837) - $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 33 / 4$ "
- Basic White card stock for stamping - $23 / 4$ " $41 / 4$ "
- Outline image is stamped using Crumb Cake ink
- Leaves are stamped with Soft Succulent ink, flower images are Pale Papaya and Calypso Coral ink
- Using the Stamparatus to line up images makes 2 -step stamping easy
- Basic White with stamped image is added to the card front with Stampin' Dimensionals, everything else is adhered with liquid adhesive or Stampin' Seal.
- Brass Butterflies and an Iridescent Pearl add a little sparkle on the card
- Suggestion - use a light hand when adhering the metallic specialty paper with liquid adhesive to avoid lines
- Add stamped greeting and/or images or designer paper to the inside of the card and envelope

## Dainty Flowers Designer Paper Card (bottom):

- Dainty Flowers $12^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ Designer Paper - \#160834
- Designer Paper sheets are cut to either $4^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ or $3^{3 / 4 \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ depending on pattern
- Card bases are $414^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ scored at $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ for top folding card
- Colors for card bases: Mossy Meadow, Old Olive, Crushed Curry, Rich Razzleberry, Starry Sky or Blushing Bride
- If desired, stamp the card front with the Hand-Drawn Dots (\#160508) using the same color ink as the card base
- Before adhering designer paper to card base, stamp your favorite greeting on the paper
- Add embellishment of your choice if desired
- I've used Framed Florets Photopolymer stamp set, Inspired Thoughts Cling Mount stamp set and Quiet Meadow Cling Mount stamp set for my greetings.
- Add stamped greeting and/or images or designer paper to the inside of the card and envelope
- Three samples below with the Dainty Flowers Designer Series Paper
- The Ovals are cut $3^{3 / 4^{\prime \prime}} \times 5$ and the other design is $4^{\prime \prime} \times 5 \frac{1 / 4^{\prime \prime}}{}$
