Corner Squash Fun Fold Card (top left):

- I'm using the Favored Flowers Sale-a-Bration paper
- Start with a piece of designer series paper and cut down to 7" x 8 1/4", then score 2 sides at 2 3/4"
- Mark with a pencil 5 1/2" along the top and left hand side, score diagonally across the designer paper connecting the two marked points
- Fold score lines, bringing diagonal score line inward (see photo below)
- Using card stock that coordinates back to your designer series paper
 - Large mat – 3 1/4" x 4 1/2" – cut 2
 - Smaller mat – 3" x 4 1/4" – cut 2
 - Basic White or Very Vanilla – 2 3/4" x 4" – cut 2
 - Designer Series Paper – 3" x 4 1/4" (inside flap – see photo below)
- Use the stamp set of your choice to decorate the front and inside Basic White or Very Vanilla card stock
- When folded card fits in standard medium envelope.



Rain or Shine Card (top right):

- Card sketch layout is from the February 2023 Sheet load of Cards by Crafty AI on YouTube.
- Rain or Shine Specialty Designer Series Paper and Playing in the Rain Bundle
- Balmy Blue card stock base – 4 ¼” x 11”, scored at 5 ½”
- Balmy Blue card stock mat – 3 ¾” x 5 ½”
- 4 pieces of designer series paper – 1” x 3 ¾” (add to the top & bottom of the mat listed above)
- Balmy Blue card stock 2 ½” x 4 ¼”
- Designer Series paper – 2 ¼” x 4” (adhered to mat listed above)
- Die cut from the Rain or Shine Specialty designer series paper, adhered with Stampin’ Dimensionals
- Greeting stamped in Balmy Blue ink on Basic White card stock, die cut with Stylish Shape Die
- Add about 6” – 8” of Balmy Blue / White Variegated Ribbon, folded in half and added to the back of the die above then added to the card front
- Decorate with the embellishment of your choice.

Irresistible Blooms Card (bottom):

- Irresistible Blooms Bundle and Hello Irresistible Designer Series Paper (both items due back in stock in April)
- Sahara Sand card stock base 5 ½” x 8 ½”, scored at 4 ¼”
- Stamp splatter image on opposite top and bottom corners, using Sahara Sand or Pretty Peacock Ink (a returning color in May23)
- 2 squares of designer series paper 3” x 3” – you can either use both pieces as is or cut one in half for 2 pieces 1 ¾” x 3) – add to card front
- Die cut circle or long die using Rose Gold Foil Paper and add to card front using liquid glue – you can also add adhesive sheet to the back of the foil paper before die cutting and turn the die cut into a sticker for easier application. Circle die cut uses card stock piece about 3 ¾” x 3 ¾” and long die uses piece about 1 ½” x 6”.
- Stamp greeting on Very Vanilla card stock and die cut with die from Something Fancy Dies.

- Die cut flowers and leaves from the designer paper with coordinating dies and add to card front with a mix of Stampin' Dimensionals and liquid glue.
- Add embellishment of your choice . I've used the Loose Frosted Dots which are currently on backorder.
