

3 in 1 Fun Fold Card

Especially for You from Karen Thomas, Your Stampin' Up! Demonstrator

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Cutting & Scoring:

- Main Card base (Poppy Parade on mine) 5 ¼" x 8 ¾"
- Pretty Peacock card stock Mats
 - \circ 2 3 ¼" x 3 ¼" (adhered to card base)
 - \circ 2 2 ¾" x 2 ¾" (used at mat for 3" x 3" card)
 - \circ 7 15/8" x 15/8"
- Basic White card stock
 - 2 3" x 6" scored at 3" (small cards added to the card)
 - 2 2 ½" x 2 ½" (on mine card, I used the punch and cake stamp instead for one)
- Designer Series Paper
 - o 7-1½" x 1½"

Instructions:

- 1. Follow instructions below to create the card base
- 2. Burnish all score line with bone folder
 - a. Burnish the 2 center score line inward
 - b. Top score will fold towards the back
 - c. Bottom score will fold towards the front
- 3. Adhere the 7 square of designer series paper to their mats, then to the card base.
- 4. For me, I found stamping and decorating the 3" x 3" cards first, then adding to the main card was the easiest.

A Gift for You from Karen Thomas, your Stampin' Up! Demonstrator

Card Base - 5 1/4" x 8 3/4"

- With 8 ¾" side at the top, SCORE at 3 ½" and 5 ¼"
- Adhere the 3 ¼" x 3 ¼" card stock mats to the top right & bottom left corners, leaving an even border (this helps with the next step.
- With the 8 ¾" at the top, line up at 1 ¾" and SCORE down 1 ¾" (just above the card stock mat you added). Rotate card stock 180 degrees and repeat.
- With the 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " at the top, line up at 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " and CUT from one score line to the other. Rotate cardstock 180 degrees and repeat.
