- On-Line Exclusives – Garden Meadow Bundle, Meandering Meadow Designer Series Paper, Three Color Glimmer Specialty Paper, and Adhesive-Backed Dragonflies & Birds

Cheers to the Season Card (top left):

- Garden Green card stock base 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½" or 5 ½" x 8 ½", scored at 4 ¼"
- 2 Pieces of Designer Series Paper ¾" x 4 ¼" (I've used One Horse Open Sleigh) – adhere to the top and bottom of the card front
- 2 Pieces of More Dazzle 6" x 6" Specialty Paper – ½" x 4 ¼" – adhere next to designer paper
- 1 Pieces of Designer Series Paper – 3 ½" x 4 ¼" – add with Stampin' Dimensionals (may find it easier to add the dimensionals to the card front, then add the designer paper.

- Deckled Circle Dies – Basic White card stock
 - Front – about 3 ¼” wide (once stamped, added with Stampin’ Dimensionals)
 - Inside – about 4” wide
- Stamp sets:
 - Front – Cheers to the Season – Real Red ink
 - Inside – Very Best Occasions – Real Red ink
- Cheerful Daisy Dies – Early Espresso die cuts and Bough Punch for Real Red pieces
- 3 - Festive Pearls or Adhesive-Backed Sparkle Gems for embellishments

Light the Sky Card (top right):

- Thick Basic White card stock base 4 ¼” x 11”, scored at 5 ½” or 5 ½” x 8 ½”, scored at 4 ¼”
- Basic White card stock 4 1/8” x 5 3/8” – die cut with 3 of the dies from the Light the Sky Bundle
- Pieces of More Dazzle 6” x 6” Specialty Paper – 4” x 5 ¼”, adhered to the Basic White die cut piece, then to the card front with Stampin’ Dimensionals
- More Dazzle 6” x 6” Specialty Paper – ¾” x 4”, banner cut edges
- Deckled Circle Die about 2 ½” wide, stamped with greeting in Starry Sky
- Stamp images from the stamp set inside (lower left or right corner)

Garden Meadow Card (middle):

- Based on the piece of designer paper used, card base and mat colors will vary. Directions are for card shown.
- Night of Navy card stock base 4 ¼” x 11”, scored at 5 ½” or 5 ½” x 8 ½”, scored at 4 ¼”
- Fresh Freesia card stock 4” x 5 ¼” – die cut the arch out of the middle (arch will be stamped and used on the inside)
- Run die cut piece for the front through the embossing folder of your choice. I’ve used Painted Textures 3D folder.
- Meandering Meadows Designer Series Paper (6” x 6” piece – no waste)
 - Front – 3 ¾” x 5” for front
 - Inside – 3 ¾” x 1” for inside
 - Envelope flap – 2 ¼” x 6” (once adhered cut off excess)
- Adhere the front piece of designer paper to the embossed Fresh Freesia, then to card front.
- Highland Heather Glimmer Paper – ½” x 3” (from the Three Color Glimmer On-line exclusive 12” x 12” Specialty Paper)
- Greeting on Basic White card stock ½” x 4”, cut down to size of greeting. Adhere to glimmer paper, then to card front with Stampin’ Dimensionals.
- Inside – add inside piece of designer paper, then stamped arch
- Finish front with Adhesive-Backed Dragonflies & Birds (Due in stock week of November 27th)
