### **Layered Florals 3D Embossed Card (bottom two cards):**

- Card stock base 5 ½" x 8 ½", scored at 4 ¼"
- Sale-a-Bration – Flight & Airy 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper – 4" x 5 ¼"
- Run the designer paper through the Cut & Emboss Machine using the Layered Florals 3D Embossing Folder
- Adhere designer paper to card front
- Next to the largest Stylish Circle die, is cut using matching card stock to the card base. Adhere to card front using Stampin' Dimensionals
- Decorative Circle Punch (#159174) - Basic White card stock, stamp with greeting of your choice in color of your choice

### **Meadow Fun Fold Card (top left):**

- Card stock base 5 ½" x 8 ½" scored at 4 ¼"
- Fun Fold card stock for front – 5 ½" x 6 ¼", score both ends of the 6 ¼" side at ½" and 1"
- In the middle section of the Fun Fold card piece, die cut window using arch die from the Garden Meadow Dies
- Next, embossing the middle section of the Fun Fold card piece with an embossing folder (I've used the Distressed Tile 3D Folder)
- Cut piece of designer series paper 4" x 5 ¼", center and add to the front of the card base
- Burnish the score marks on the Fun Fold card piece (valley then mountain fold on each end)
- Add Tear & Tape to the edges ( ½" score piece) of the Fun Fold piece and adhere to the card front. While the card is "bowed," you will be able to flatten and insert it into a standard envelope.
- Decorate as desired. Recommend you not use many dimensionals but add greetings to the designer paper.

### **Bee Mine Card (top right):**

- Pool Party card stock base 5 ½" x 8 ½", score at 2 1/8" on each end of the 8 ½" side
- Turn card stock sideways (5 ½" side at the top), cut on the trimmer at 1 1/8" from score line to score line on both sides
- Once the cuts are made, put the 8 ½" side of the paper at the top of your scoring tool and at the 4 ¼" mark, score down to the cut line on both sides
- Fold up ONLY the top and bottom 4 ¼" scores, gentle fold down & flat the middle section of the card (once you try this it makes sense). This is the section you will add the Basic Black card stock to.
- Bee Mine Designer Series Paper:
  - Bee's – 2 @ 1 7/8" x 5 1/4"
  - Red Flowers – 4 @ 7/8" x 1 7/8"
  - Adhere to card
- Basic Black card stock – 3 ¼" x 4"
- Basic White card stock 3 1/8" x 3 7/8"
- Basic White card stock – 1 7/8" x 5 ¼" (for the back of the card for signing)
- Stamp desired design on Basic White card stock
- Bee is stamped with Memento Black Ink of Daffodil Delight Card stock and punched out with Bee Punch
- Wings are stamped in Petal Pink & Antenna in Memento Black and Punched out with Bee Punch
- Adhere wings and antenna with Mini Glue Dot to Bee then to card front
- Back of the Bee Card.
