- Rock Star Bundle #162706 & Rock & Roll 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper #162695
 - Trusty Tool Bundle #162723 & Trusty Toolbox Designer Paper (SAB Level 1)
- Thoughtful Expressions Dies #162821 (part of Thoughtful Expressions Bundle #162822)
 - Watercolor Melon Photopolymer Stamp Set (SAB Level 1)
 - Softly Sophisticated Bundle (SAB Level 2)

Rock & Roll Fun Fold Card (top left):

- Card stock Measurements:
 - Colored Card stock base – 4 ¼" x 5 ½"
 - Basic White Card stock base layer – 4" x 5 ¼"
 - Designer Series Paper card base – 3 ¾" x 5"
 - Basic White Fun Fold Layer – 5 ¼" x 7 ¼", score at 1 3/8", 2 ½", 4 ¾" and 5 7/8"
 - Designer Paper for front panels – 1 1/8" x 5"
 - Focal Image
 - Colored card stock layer – 2 1/8" x 4 ¾"
 - Basic White card stock image layer – 2" x 4 5/8"
 - Basic White scraps for stamping
- Layer first 3 card stock measurements together for card base

- Fold and burnish with bone folder the fun fold layer (mountain, valley, valley, mountain folds)
- Decorate as desired inside middle, adhere to card base, matching up the Basic White layers
- Add designer paper to the two outside sections
- Stamp images and greeting, color and die cut
- Layer Basic White focal card stock to the colored card stock layer, then add that unit to left front of card (make sure card can still open). Add die cut pieces (guitar, picks and greeting)
- Finish card with Adhesive-Backed Lighting & Stars #162709

Toolbox Card (top left):

- Gray Granite card stock base – 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½"
- Trusty Toolbox Designer Series Paper – 3 ½" x 4 ¾" and 1 ¾" x 4 ¼"
- Pecan Pie card stock 2 ½" x 4" for peg board die cut
- Tools of your choice (either cut from designer paper or stamped and die cut)
- Sentiment (you're the most awesome) stamped on Basic White card stock using Gray Granite ink from the Trusty Tool Bundle
- Best Family Ever Photopolymer Stamp set (#160720) also used Deckled Rectangles or Nested Essential Dies for greeting
- Cork Circle Embellishment

Watercolor Melon or Softly Sophisticated Card (bottom):

- Both cards use the same layout, different stamp sets
- Basic White card stock base – 5 ½" x 8 ½"
- Basic White card stock – 3 ½" x 4 ¾", embossed with folder from Softly Sophisticated Bundle (SAB level 2)
- Basic White card stock with largest of the oblong die from Thoughtful Expressions Dies
- Watermelon card:
 - Shaded Spruce, Real Red and Night of Navy ink
- Softly Sophisticated card:
 - Highland Heather, Lemon Lime Twist and Daffodil Delight
- Add Embellishments of your choice
