Featured Products this Month:

- Filled with Happiness Photopolymer Stamp Set - # 162915 (retiring)
- Perennial Lavender Designer Series Paper - # 162593 (not retiring)
 - Filled with Fun Bundle - # 163561 (Online Exclusive)

Happiness Card (top left):

- Pecan Pie card stock base 5 ½" x 8 ½", scored at 4 ¼"
- Perennial Lavender DSP – 3 strips (2 – 1 ½" x 4" and 1 – 1" x 4") or 3 strips (1" x 4", 1 ¼" x 4" 1 ½" x 4")
- Adhere DSP to card stock as shown (may want to use 3" x 4" piece of Very Vanilla to estimate spacing).
- Very Vanilla card stock 3" x 4" – stamp greeting of your choice in Pecan Pie ink and adhere to card front.
- Very Vanilla card stock 2" x 4" – stamp image on this piece, color with watercolor pencils then use Blender Pens to spread out the color, punch out with Modern Oval Punch
- Adhere image using Stampin' Dimensionals over the image on card front
- Embellish as desired

Filled with Fun Card (top right):


- Pecan Pie card stock base $5\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$, scored at $4\frac{1}{4}''$
- Stamp image of choice (flowers or presents) on scrap of Basic White card stock, color with Stampin' Blend Markers and die cut
- Wagon Die Cut pieces:
 - Wagon – Real Red card stock
 - Wheels – Basic Black card stock
 - Inside of Wheels & Handle – Basic Gray card stock
- Adhere Wagon pieces together. Dry fit on Basic White card stock $3\frac{1}{4}'' \times 4\frac{1}{4}''$, stamping greeting on the top and grass on the bottom. Grass stamp is from Trucking Along Stamp Set.
- Add wagon to card front using Stampin' Dimensionals. Suggest adding dimensionals on where the pieces are joined for added security.

Triple Flap Card (bottom):

- Card stock
 - Base – $5\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$, scored at $1'' - 2\frac{1}{4}'' - 3\frac{1}{8}'' - 4\frac{1}{4}''$
 - Flaps (should be same color as base)
 - $3\frac{3}{4}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$ and $2\frac{3}{4}'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}''$
- Mat (can be designer series paper or card stock)
 - $4\frac{1}{8}'' \times 5\frac{3}{8}''$
 - $3\frac{5}{8}'' \times 4\frac{3}{8}''$
 - $2\frac{5}{8}'' \times 3\frac{3}{8}''$
- Designer Paper – Focus image
 - $4'' \times 5\frac{1}{4}''$
 - $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{4}''$
 - $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 3\frac{1}{4}''$

Follow the measurements below to cut away pieces marked with "X"

First measurement is $3\frac{1}{8}''$ and between 3rd & 4th scores is $4\frac{1}{2}''$



Once the pieces are cut away, burnish scores (Mountain – Valley – Mountain). Adhere the flaps as shown below. It's easy to see which flap goes on which section. Add mats and designer paper. Additional pieces of card stock can be added to the back for greetings or just for designer series paper. Greeting page can also be adhered to the back at 4" x 5 ¼"

For backs of the smaller pieces:

- 2 5/8" x 3 3/8"
- 3 5/8" x 4 3/8"
