## Featured Products this Month:

- Designer Tag Dies - # 163561 (Online Exclusive)
- Country Woods 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper - # 159165
- Shimmery White Embossing Paste - # 145645 & Palette Knives - # 142808
- Mediterranean Blooms 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper - # 163284
  - Citrus Blooms Bundle - # 163295
- Take to the Sky 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper - # 163436
  - Adventurous Sky Bundle - # 163447
  - Industrial Trinkets - # 163450

### Designer Tag Card (top left):

- Petal Pink card stock base 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½"
- Early Espresso card stock mat 4" x 5 ¼", die cut tag from the inside of this piece to save card stock
- Country Woods Designer Series Paper mat – 3 7/8" x 5 1/8"
- Use the rose die from the Designer Series Dies to create a mask with a piece of card stock about 4 ¼" x 4 ¼"
- Place the rose mask over the Early Espresso tag and use the Palette Knife to add Shimmery Embossing paste
- If desired, put some embossing paste on a silicone mat and mix in a few drops of Petal Pink reinker or the color of your choice before spreading over mask.
- Add designer paper to card stock mat, thread about 7" of ribbon through the die, adhere to the back of the mat, then to card front.
- Stamp and die cut greeting of your choice with Stampin' Dimensionals and add embellishments of choice.

**Citrus card and tag (top right):**

- Mediterranean Blooms Designer Series Paper and Citrus Blooms Bundle
- Daffodil Delight card stock base 5 ½" x 8 ½", scored at 4 ¼" or 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½"
- Garden Green card stock 4 ¼" x 5 ½" – use this to die cut the greenery dies that nest together, including large border die. Separate into three pieces, we will be using the inside on the tag and large die cut is adhered to the card front.
- Use dies to cut orange cluster from designer series paper, add to card with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Add bow with Mini Glue dot and greeting of your choice, stamped in Garden Green and die cut with die of our choice. I've used Perennial Postage die.
- For tag, cut one from designer series paper and from card stock, tie together with ribbon.
  - Add smaller greenery to the front along with some coordinating flowers from dies in the bundle

**Take to the Sky Fun Fold Card (bottom):**

- Copper Clay card stock base 5 ¼" x 8 ½", scored at 1 ¼" and 4 ¼"
  - 1 ¼" score is a Mountain Fold and 4 ¼" score is the center of the card
- Take to the Sky Designer Series Paper
  - 2 ¾" x 5 ¼"
  - 1" x 5 ¼" (need 2)
- Basic White card stock for inside – 2 ¾" x 5 ¼", stamp with images, greeting of your choice from bundle
- Focal Image
  - Copper Clay card stock mat – 4 ½" x 3 ¼"
  - Basic White card stock for stamping – 4 ¼" x 3"
    - Stamp clouds in Boho Blue
    - Die cut clouds using Basic White card stock and add Shimmery Embossing Paste for texture
    - Clouds are added with Stampin' Dimensionals AFTER the plane is added
    - Make sure when the card is closed, clouds are not outside the border.
  - Plane – Smoky Slate & Mossy Meadow card stock
- Greeting section
  - Copper Clay card stock - 1" x 2 ½"
  - Basic White card stock – ¾" x 2 ¼"
  - Mossy Meadow for greeting, add greeting with Stampin' Dimensionals to "stop" the Focal Image and have it Pop Up!
