# Cardsandcraftswithkaren.com Karen Thomas, Independent Stampin' Up! Demonstrator



## Puzzle Card (top left):

- Real Red card stock base 4 ¼" x 9 ½", score at 1" and 2" on both ends of the 9 ½" side
- Inside 4" x 5 ¼" Basic White, stamp and add this piece first
- Front mat start with piece 4" x 5 ¼" (I've used Garden Green), and cut the 4" side at 2", then cut as below
  - o 2 pieces 2" x 3"
  - o 2 pieces 2" x 2 1/4"
- Designer Series Paper
  - o 2 pieces 1 ¾" x 2 ¾"
  - o 2 pieces 1 ¾" x 2"
- Products used:
  - o Take a Bow 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper item 164309 \$12.50
  - o More Than Autumn Bundle item 164076 \$47.50
  - o Real Red & White Adhesive Backed Peppermints item 164050 \$8.50
  - o Memento Black Ink, Real Red ink and Pecan Pie Stampin' Blend Markers

## Heart Die Card (right):

- Online Exclusive Products:
  - Hearts of Elegance Bunde item 164916 \$50.25
  - o Marbled Elegance 12" x 12" Specialty Designer Series Paper item 164919 \$16.50
  - o Adhesive Backed Heart Sequins item 164920 \$8.50
- Thick Basic White card stock base, 4 ¼" x 11" scored at 5 ½"
- Die cut 5 hearts and adhere to card front, some with Stampin' Dimensionals. Only heart die cut using Gold Foil Paper (using a piece of wax paper between die & paper makes release easier with the detailed heart die).
- Piece of Basic White card stock 1 ¼" x 4 ¼", stamp greeting of choice in Melon Mambo ink, adhered with Stampin' Dimensionals
- You may find it easier to add the greeting first, then the die cut hearts.
- Add 3 or 5 Adhesive Backed Heart Sequins to finish card.

#### Triple Z-Fold Card (bottom left):

#### Card Base:

- Card stock 4 ¼" x 11", score at 2 ¾" and 5 ½"
- Designer Series Paper 2 ½" x 4" (2 pieces) and one piece 4" x 5 ¼"

#### Middle Layer:

- Card stock 3" x 11", score at 4 ¼" and 7"
- Designer Series Paper 2 ¾" x 4"; 2 ½" x 2 ¾" and 2 ¾" x 3 ¾"

#### Front Layer:

- Card stock 1 ¼" x 11", score at 2 ¾" and 5 ½"
- Designer Series Paper 1" x 5 ¼" and 1" x 2 ½" (2 pieces)

With these measurements, all three card stock base layer can be cut from one piece of 8 ½" x 11" card stock. Embellish as desired based on designer series paper used.

For the back of the card, use a piece of Basic White card stock 4" x 5 1/4"
