### Bloom Impressions Strips Card (top left):

- Bloom Impression 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper (Sale-a-bration item number 164944)
- Thick Basic White cardstock base  $-4 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 11" scored at 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " (top fold card)
- 10-12 Strips of designer series paper 1/2" x 4" and 2 strips of coordinating card stock 1/4" x 5 1/2"
- Piece of Basic White card stock 2 ½" x 5 ½", hold across the front of the card on the diagonal, flip over and cut off excess; add strips of designer series paper, cutting off excess then adhere piece to the card front.
- Add thin strips of coordinating card stock, mine are Blackberry Bliss and ¼" wide, cut 5 ½" long, then
  excess cut off
- Stamp sentiment.

### Pick a Season Card (top right):

- Pick a Season Stamp Set (Sale-a-bration item number 164969)
- Pecan Pie card stock base 5 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 8 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>", score at 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>"
- Stamp images from Elements of Text stamp set in Pecan Pie ink on card front
- Add 3 " x 4" piece of Everyday Happiness Designer Series Paper
- Using Very Vanilla card stock, die cut rectangle from the new Online Exclusive (starting March 4<sup>th</sup>) Textured Notes Dies (item 165555 - \$31) from the Textured Notes Bundle (item 165556 - \$48.50)
- Stamp sentiment of your choice of the top of the rectangle
- Stamp images from the stamp set (colors I've used include Pecan Pie, Shaded Spruce, Garden Green, Petunia Pop).
- Add embellishments of your choice

## Birthday Card and Covered Note pad to use at a gift!



### Wildflower Birthday Suite

Birthday Celebration Bundle Wildflower Birthday 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper Gold 1 ½" Weave Trim Ribbon Party Dots

### Pop Out Surprise Card:

- Card base and parts using same color card stock
  - o 5 ½" x 8", scored at 2" − 4" − 6"
  - Belly Band 1" x 10"
  - $\circ$  Pop-Out Mechanism 1" x 5", scored at  $\frac{1}{2}$ " and 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ "
- Designer Series Paper
  - Front Panels (2) 1 <sup>3</sup>⁄<sub>4</sub>" x 5 <sup>1</sup>⁄<sub>4</sub>"
  - Inside Panels (2) 1 <sup>3</sup>⁄<sub>4</sub>" x 5 <sup>1</sup>⁄<sub>4</sub>"
  - Inside Panels 2<sup>nd</sup> set (2) 1 <sup>3</sup>⁄<sub>4</sub>" x 5 <sup>1</sup>⁄<sub>4</sub>"
- Basic White card for back  $(2) 1 \frac{3}{4}$  x 5  $\frac{1}{4}$
- With the card base, fold left and right scores to the center just a standard gate fold card, add designer series paper to the front and back of those sections
- Middle portion of the card, burnish the 4" score as a mountain fold; Burnish ends of the Pop-Out Mechanism and adhere to the two center panels of the card (just inside the 2" and 6" score lines).
- Add remaining pieces of designer series paper to the middle section, under the Pop-Out Mechanism,
- Add decoration of your choice to the Pop-Out, making sure the card will close.

- Stamp and add the Basic White panels to the back of the card.
- Close card, wrap belly band around and secure. I've added ribbon around as well. Decorate as desired.

#### Covered Note Pad:

- 4" x 6" note pad from Dollar Tree Store
- 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" piece of chip board or even two pieces of a cereal box glued together
- Card stock 4  $\frac{1}{4}$  x 6  $\frac{1}{4}$  2 pieces to cover front and back of chip board
- Card stock 4" x 8 ½", score at 6", add to front of note pad, "fold over" and glue down to the back of the note pad, I leave the "fold over" portion without glue.
- Designer Series Paper 3 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 5 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" for front cover

To present as gift, I've used a self-sealing cellophane bag 6" x 9" from Amazon. Have the sealing part of the bag at the bottom. Tie a bow around using about 24 inches of Gold 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Weave Trim Ribbon.
