

Linked Together Card (left):

- Thick Basic White card base 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½" for top folding card
- Piece of designer series paper 4" x 5 1/4", adhered to card front
- Two Latice die cuts from the Linked Together Bundle, item# 164810, adhere to the designer series
 paper. I've only added liquid glue to the outside of the die cut, since other images will be adhered to the
 lattice part.
- Diamond die cut in coordinating color and oval die cut in Basic White card stock. Both dies are from the bundle.
- Greeting from the bundle stamped on the oval die cut. All die cuts added directly to the card front.
- Die cut flowers and adhere. Add embellishment of your choice to the centers.

Pop-Up Gate Fun Fold Card (right):

- Thick Basic White card stock base $5\frac{1}{2}$ x 8", scored at $1\frac{7}{8}$ $3\frac{1}{4}$ " $4\frac{1}{4}$ " $6\frac{1}{8}$ "
- Scores on the outside fold in (valley) and two in the middle fold out (mountain)
- Textured Notes Dies (2nd and 3rd largest) colored card stock and Basic White these are adhered only to the ½" section in the middle of the card base. Make sure to stamp on the Basic White die cut before adhering to the card front. Easier if you add adhesive to the middle section then add die cuts.
- 4 pieces of designer series paper 1 3/4" x 5 3/8" on the card front.
- Optional 2 pieces of designer series paper for the card back (1 3/4" x 5 3/8")
- I've added a 1 3/4" x 5 3/8" Basic White card stock piece I've stamped and can sign on the back of the card.

All Zipped Up Card:

- Card features the All Zipped Up Bundle item 165402
- Card base 5 ½" x 8 ½", score at 4 ¼" side fold or 4 ¼" x 11" scored at 5 ½" for top fold card
- Designer Series Paper 4" x 5 1/4"
- Card stock for the pockets and strips beside the zipper
- Zipper Pieces are die cut using the Textured Metallic 12" x 12" Specialty Paper
- Once you have your zipper pieces die cut, use the main zipper die cut to figure out how much of the
 designer series paper needs to be cut away so that a "shirt" can be added. This may take a few cuts, so
 you have just what is needed cut away. Add zipper and side pieces for the designer series paper, cut off
 any excess, add "shirt," then add to the card front.
- For the pockets, dry emboss with the embossing folder of your choice if desired.
- Zipper pull added with a mini glue dot. This will cover where the 2 zipper pieces meet.
