- Delicate Dreams Specialty Designer Series Paper - #167498 - \$16.50

### Cutest Crew Card (left):

- Crumb Cake card base – 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½."
- Stamp either the strip of dogs or cats from the Cutest Crew stamp set using Memento Black or Secret Sea ink. Die cut with coordinating die. Color as desired and adhere directly to card front.
- I've die cut one of the individual dogs dies using Pecan Pie card stock and adhered to the strip. Cats also have individual cat die cuts.
- Die cut the strip of paw prints using color of your choice. I have used Poppy Parade for the dogs and Darling Duckling for the cats. Add to card front and cut off any excess.
- Stamp greeting of your choice on card front.
- Inside I have stamped the paw image and additional greetings.

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### **Forever Florals Card (right):**

- Gray Granite card stock – 4 ¼” x 11”, score at 5 ½”
- Gray Granite card stock – 4” x 5 ½” embossed with the Forever Plaid 3D Embossing Folder. Add directly to the card front.
- Secret Sea card stock mat – 3 ¾” x 4 ¼”
- Delicate Dreams Specialty Designer Series Paper – 3 ½” x 4”, cut to 1” x 4” and 2 ½” x 4.”
- Delicate Designs Specialty Designer Series Paper – 2” x 3” and 1” x 4”
- Add designer paper to mat as in photo, then to card base.
- Floral cluster is die cut from the Delicate Dreams Specialty Designer Series Paper, cut in half, add behind the label once greeting is stamped using Secret Sea ink. Add entire unit to the card base using Stampin’ Dimensionals.
- Add embellishments – Natural Matte Dots.

### **Designer Paper Extended Z Fold Card (middle):**

- Poppy Parade card stock base – 4 ¼” x 11”, scored at 1 ¼” and 5 ½.”
- Cut as a Bug Designer Series Paper (DSP) – 2 pieces 4” x 4” and 1 piece 1” x 4.”
- Basic White card stock 4” x 5 ¼”. Adhere the 1” x 4” DSP to the right side of the Basic White. Cut a piece of the Old Olive Rick Rack Ribbon about 6” long, secure on the left side of the DSP strip.
- Stamp images of your choice from the Sweet Bug stamp set on the left side of the Basic White card stock piece, color as desired and add to the card base.
- Add one of the 4” x 4” pieces of DSP to the inside of the card.
- On the 1 ¼” section of the card base, add the other piece of DSP to “extend” out the card. Make sure to match the Basic White card stock top & bottom.
- Using Stylish Shapes Die, die cut the largest square using Old Olive card stock and next size down using Basic White card stock. The Basic White piece has been embossed using the Ladybug Picnic 3D Embossing Folder. Add squares together, then to card front.
- Die cut a couple mushrooms using Pecan Pie and Cajun Craze card stock. Die cut the little images using Basic White and add to card.
- Stamp and die cut bee of your choice, color and add to the card with Stampin’ Dimensionals.
- Smallest die from the Beautifully Celebrated Die is using Petal Pink card stock for the greeting.
- Ladybug embellishment finishes the card.
