Lilly of the Valley Card (left):

- Basic Beige card stock base 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½" for top fold card.
- Using Luxe White Specialty Designer Series Paper and Valley in Bloom Designer Series Paper cut a piece 2 ¾" x 4 ¾" from each. Adhere to card front at an angle, overlapping.
- Granny Apple Green card stock 2 ½" x 4 ½"; stamp large floral image in Garden Green ink, then adhere to card front centering top to bottom and left to right.
- Stamp 2 small floral images, color leaves with Granny Apple Green and top of bells with Barely Blush Stampin' Blend Markers then die cut.
- Die cut fence looking die cut using Blackberry Bliss card stock. Add floral images and this piece to card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.

- Greeting is from Lilly of the Valley Bundle and stamped on Scallop from the Scalloped Bloom Dies in Garden Green ink.
- Add 3 Shimmering Dots for embellishment.

Homemade Sweetness Card (right):

- Crushed Curry card stock base 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½" for top fold card.
- Homemade Sweetness Designer Series Paper, 2 coordinating designs – 1 cut at 4" x 4" and the other cut at 3" x 4".
- On the 4" x 4" square rip away about ¼" – ½" from what will be the bottom of the square.
- On the 3" x 4" square, determine what will be the top and rip away about ¼" – ½".
- Adhere the pieces to the card front. There will be a gap between the two pieces of designer paper.
- Sweet Words & Labels Die cuts (Misty Moonlight and Basic White)
- Stamp greeting of your choice in Misty Moonlight ink, adhere pieces to card front.
- Fussy cut jam jars and add to the card front as embellishments.
- For the bottom of the inside, I have added the torn off designer paper for interest.

Vase Card (middle):

- Phrases & Frames Stamp set used for both card front and inside card greetings.
- Phrases & Frames Bundle #167587, using with the Impressions Plate #167767
- Thick Basic White card base 5 ½" x 8 ½", scored at 4 ¼."
- Pretty Peacock card stock 4" x 5 ¼"
- Piece of Paper Medley Designer Series Paper 6" x 6" (will get 4 pieces for 4 cards)
 - On each side measure at 1 ½" and make a pencil mark
 - Using your paper cutter, from top mark to bottom mark, cut the paper.
 - Hold paper together, turn ¼ turn, cut from mark to mark.
 - You should end up with 4 pieces of designer series paper.
 - Each piece can be used in a corner of a card base.
 - Stamp greeting of your choice.
 - Adhere to Pretty Peacock mat.
- Fussy cut vase with flowers from the Artisan Sketched Garden Designer Series Paper, adhere to card front, use Stampin' Dimensionals if you like.
- This makes a cute 4 card set you can use as a gift!
